

Emmett Bagwell Dies at His Home

Emmitt Bagwell, 56, 1007 E. Foster St., died unexpectedly at 4:15 p.m. Tuesday at his home. He had had a heart ailment for some time, but had worked Tuesday morning.

Born May 23, 1907 in Howard County, he was the son of George and Alecta (Hicks) Bagwell. Mr. Bagwell was married June 26, 1928 at Kokomo to Dorothy Clark, who survives.

He was formerly employed at the Hoosier Iron Works and Palmer School, and his latest employment was as custodian of Fairlawn United Brethren Church.

Mr. Bagwell was a member of Fairlawn Church and taught the Good Fellowship Sunday School Class there.

Survivors include the widow; the mother, of Kokomo; four sons, Robert, William and Fred, all of Kokomo, and Russel at home; one daughter, Marsha, at home; two sisters, Mrs. Claude (Ruth) Phillips and Miss Daisy Bagwell, both of Kokomo; and nine grandchildren. Three brothers and two sisters are deceased.

Funeral services will be at 2 p.m. Friday in Fairlawn UB Church, with the Rev. Luke J. Martin officiating. The body will lie in state there one hour preceding the services. Burial will be in Albright Cemetery.
