KEMPTON—Roy F. Graham, 65, died at his home in Goldsmith at 5:30 a.m. Monday after suffering a coronary attack.

Born in Goldsmith, Oct. 18, 1896 he was the son of Charles and Sarah E. (Brown) Graham.

In 1928 he was married to Miss Mabel R. Henry, who survives with two sons: Walter Graham, who is serving with the Armed Forces in Puerto Rico, and Charles R. Graham, who is stationed at Lackland AFB, Tex.; two daughters: Mrs. Sarah Mae Golden of Ogden, Utah, and Miss Mildred C. Graham, at home.
