

Lawrence R. Gustin

Lawrence R. Gustin, 54, Kokomo R. R. 6, died at 3:50 a.m. Saturday in Howard Community Hospital after an extended illness.

He was born Aug. 25, 1909 in Howard County, the son of Charles and Lola (Armfield) Gustin, and had lived in Kokomo all his life. In 1946 he was married to Gertrude Jacobs, who survives.

Mr. Gustin was employed by Delco Radio Division from 1948 until he retired in 1961 because of failing health.

He was a member of South Side Wesleyan Methodist Church. He served in the navy during World War II, in both the European and Asian theaters of operation.

Surviving are one daughter, Mrs. A. A. (Marilyn) Stegman of Bucklin, Kans.; one son, William Gustin of Kansas City, Mo.; his mother, Mrs. Lola Gustin of Kokomo; 10 grandchildren; and one niece, Miss Helen Gustin of Kokomo. One brother and one sister are deceased.
