Danny Stephen Hale, 58, 2411 N. Buckeye St., died in St. Joseph Memorial Hospital at 10:45 p.m. Wednesday following a one month's illness.

Born in LaFollette, Tenn., Nov. 4, 1906, he was the son of David and Louisa (Lynch) Hale. He had been a resident here for the past 38 years.
