

Services slated for crash victim

Funeral services for Larry Joe Williams, 27, Nyona Lake, will be at 2 p.m. Monday in the Ellers Funeral Chapel. Burial will follow in Albright Cemetery.

Williams was killed Friday night when the car he was driving went out of control and slammed into a utility pole about 10 miles north of Logansport.

He was born in Kokomo on April 7, 1938 to Justin Dan and Leona (Elmore) Williams and was a 1955 graduate of Kokomo High School. He had resided at Lake Nyona for the past three years.

An employe of Delco Radio, Williams had served in the U.S. Navy from 1955 to 1959.

He is survived by one son, Scotty Joe, a former wife, Shirley Nay Williams, both of Kokomo; his parents, also of Kokomo, one sister, Mrs. Linda McGinnis, and his maternal grandparents, Mr. and Mrs. Cleo Elmore, all of Kokomo.

The family will receive visitors at the funeral chapel after 4 p.m. today.
