George E. Haseltine, 93, Kokomo, died 2:40 p.m. Tuesday, Oct. 4, 2005, at Manor Care Health Services. He was born Jan. 19, 1912, in Kokomo, a son of Frank and Elizabeth (McNamara) Haseltine. On Oct. 13, 1940, in Indianapolis, he married Carrie E. Lewis and she died July 13, 2005.

He graduated from Kokomo High School in 1931. He and his wife owned Haseltine Jewelry, which was founded by his grandparents in 1858. He closed the store and retired in 1977. He also had worked at Delco Electronics.

He was a member of the Elks, Moose and U.C.T. He was an avid Kokomo High School and Indiana University basketball fan and enjoyed going to games with his family. He was a bowler for more than 50 years and was Kokomo City Champion Bowler in 1936.

He is survived by his son, David Ross Haseltine, Kokomo; two grandsons, Matthew and wife Karen Haseltine, Walton, and Scott Haseltine, Palestine, Texas; and three great-grandchildren. In addition to his wife, he was preceded in death by his parents and a brother.

Services are 1 p.m. Saturday at Eilers Mortuary Webster Street Chapel, 3400 S. Webster St., with the Rev. Bill C. Meiring officiating. Burial will be in Crown Point Cemetery. Visitation is 4 to 8 p.m. Friday at the mortuary.
