William Howard Jr., 52, Kokomo, died approximately 6:32 p.m. Saturday, March 26, 2005, at his residence. He was born Aug. 2, 1952, in Tinker Field AFB of Oklahoma, a son of William Sr. and Judy (Fambrough) Howard. On Dec. 29, 1998, in Kokomo, he married Teresa Smith Howard and she survives.
