Ethel M. Kuntz, 99, North Fort Myers, Fla., a former Kokomo resident, died 10:30 p.m. Sunday, Aug. 31, 2003, at the Tandem Health Care Facility in North Fort Myers. She was born Sept. 25, 1903, in Terre Haute, the daughter of George W. and Mary E. (Cade) Warman. On Oct. 16, 1918, she married Faye Wyatt, who died Feb. 15, 1950. She later married Robert Kuntz on March 28, 1958, and he preceded her in death Dec. 9, 1987.

Before a recent move to Florida, she lived in Monticello, although most of her adult life she lived in Kokomo. She had also lived in Terre Haute and Detroit, Mich. She was a housewife and had worked in the cosmetic department of Turner's Department Store in Kokomo for many years.

She was a member of St. Luke United Methodist Church in Kokomo and the Rebekah Circle of the church. She was also an associate member of the Monticello Christian Church in Monticello and had held membership in the American Legion Auxiliary No. 6.

Survivors include a daughter, Florence (Wyatt) and husband James Hizer, formerly of Kokomo and Monticello; six stepchildren, Erma Critchfield, Ranghilde Koglin, Devonne Campbell, Marcia Costello, Donald Kuntz and Marjory Bowyer; 14 grandchildren; and 24 great-grandchildren. In addition to her husbands, she was preceded in death by a son, Faye Mills Wyatt Jr.; two brothers, Leo P. Warman and Chester M. Warman; and a sister, Madonna Pritchard.

Funeral services are 10 a.m. Friday at Fenn & Shirley Mortuary, Colonial Chapel, 1315 W. Lincoln Road, with the Rev. Harold Williams officiating. Burial will follow in Crown Point Cemetery.
