Greenlawn Cemetery

Greenlawn Cemetery consists of over 40 acres of high ground overlooking the Wildcat Creek Reservoir in a picturesque rural setting in Eastern Howard County. Over 15 acres have been platted and drained for cemetery use. It is endowed with a perpetual care fund of almost \$50,000.00 which helps care for the cemetery.

Rules For Greenlawn Cemetery

1. The Board of Directors or its legal representative are in sole charge of activities within grounds and their decisions will be final.
2. All arrangements for purchase of lots must be made with the Secretary or Treasurer at the fixed price. No interment of any body other than a human being will be permitted.
3. **Between March 15 and October 15 artificial flowers, statues, shepherd's hooks and vigil lights are not permitted on the ground due to mowing season.**
4. No enclosures of any kind may be permitted on any cemetery space. No **permanent flowers**, shrubs or decorations will be permitted in the cemetery.
5. **Memorial decoration for Easter, Memorial Day, July 4th and Veterans day may be placed on ground 3 days before said holidays and removed 10 days following said holidays. If not removed by the lot owner or family, cemetery personnel will remove and discard.**
6. **All decorations, flowers, vigil lights and shepherd hooks must be contained to the monument, base or foundation of all cemetery lots in a well maintained fashion.**
7. Spring clean up will always be the second full week of March. Fall clean up will always be the last full week of September.

8. Foundations for all monuments, headstones etc., will be built by the Cemetery at the expense of the lot owner.

9. Foundations will be poured twice a year being the spring and fall.

10. Foundations and Monuments will only be allowed when lots are paid in full.

11. Operation of vehicles in the cemetery must be at 5 mph and refrain from driving on the grass. Any person disturbing the quiet and good order of the Cemetery will be regarded as trespassing and may be prosecuted to the laws of the State of Indiana.

12. The Secretary and Sexton or their representative are directed to enforce the above regulations and to exclude from the Cemetery any person willfully violating the same.

13. No foot markers will be permitted other than government markers.

14. Grave blankets for the winter months shall be permitted from December 1 until Spring clean up.

Fourth Addition

The Fourth addition is hereby designated as a Memorial Addition subject to all rules and regulations already in force.

Memorial markers will be restricted to Bronze, granite or marble stones no higher than 8 inch bevel or less.

Between March 15 and October 15 artificial flowers, statues, shepherd's hooks and vigil lights are not permitted on the ground due to mowing season.

Foundations:

Foundations in all sections will be poured to specifications set by the cemetery board.

New foundations being poured will be adjoined to existing foundations when applicable.
