LOGANSPOBT -- Charles "Walter" Rhine, 95, Kokomo, died at 5:51 p.m. Friday, Oct. 1, 2004, at the Chase Center, Logansport. He was born Oct. 1, 1909, in Clinton County, the son of Charlie Andrew and Arvella E. (Lanning) Rhine. On March 17, 1934, in Paxton, Ill., he married Marjorie P. (Miller) Rhine. She survives.

He was a Burlington High School graduate. He retired from I.B.E.W., Local 873, as an electrician. He also owned and operated Rhine Electric and was the city's electrical inspector.
