RUSSEVILLE — (Tribune Area Special)—Mrs. Mary Arlene Tucker Etherington, 40, Russiaville R.R. 1, died at a Logansport hospital at 10:15 a.m. Thursday. She had been in failing health for some time but had only been serious for one day.

She was born Feb. 28, 1917, near New London, Ind., the daughter of Roscoe and Ethel (Stout) Tucker. On Nov. 25, 1943, she was married to Ralph Etherington who died April 20, 1952.
