Mary A. Hanson, the 1 child of Benjamin and Mary Morris, was born in Jackson county, Indiana, Dec. 2, 1839, and departed this life May 21, 1916, age 76 years, 5 months, 22 days. She was united in marriage to Elijah Hanson April 4, 1858. To this union were born seven children, two sons and five daughters. The husband, one son and three daughters have preceded her to the grave. The three remaining children—B. F. Hanson of Wayne county, Ind., Mrs. W. P. Hobson of near New London, and Mrs. Lee Willis of Kokomo; two grandchildren, Curtis Rich of Wichita, Kans., and Miss Marie Hobson; one brother, B. F. Morris of Iowa; one sister, Hulda Mitchell, of New London, with many other relatives and friends are left to mourn her departure. Early in her married life she united with the Friends church and has been a faithful and consistent member until the time of her death. She was also a charter member of the Woman's Christian Temperance Union, and a faithful worker in the Woman's Foreign Missionary Society. Thus we can truly say "She has fought a good fight, has kept the faith, and has entered into the rest eternal prepared for the redeemed of the Lord." The funeral was held at New London Saturday, May 27, and was conducted by the Rev. Samuel Talbert.
