

## MRS. A. J. HANSON <sup>July 1958</sup> BURIED AT N. LONDON

Funeral services for Mrs. A. J. Hanson, 90, a former Monroe township resident and the aunt of Vincent L. Hanson of here, were held Sunday afternoon at 2 o'clock at the Stout and son funeral home.

Mrs. Hanson, died Thursday at her home in Minneapolis, Minn. and the body was sent here Saturday for services and burial. Rev. Murray Kenworthy officiated at the funeral services and burial followed in the New London cemetery.

Mrs. Marietta (Morris) Hanson was born June 29, 1860, in Parke county, Indiana the daughter of Dr. Aaron W. and Margaret Morris, later of Russiaville, and was a sister of the late Mrs. Arthur Hasop.

She received the first of her schooling in Parke county and later attended the Howard county schools. She taught a few terms of school in Monroe township. Later she was married to Alfred J. Hanson. To this union were born five children, four of whom, with the husband, preceded her in death.

One daughter, Mrs. Glen F. Richards in whose home she lived, survives with four grandchildren and four great grandchildren.

Mrs. Hanson was a birthright member of the Friends church and she and her husband, the Rev. Alfred J. Hanson, filled many Friends charges in Iowa, Illinois and Indiana.
