

T. REES HAWORTH, *July*
NEW LONDON NATIVE, 5
IS HEART VICTIM *1952*

T. Rees Haworth, a native of New London who had made his home in California for more than 20 years, died of a heart ailment at Pomona Saturday. He was 71.

Born near New London where he was educated, he was the son of Clarkson and Sophrona (Rees) Haworth of pioneer stock. In 1904 he was married to Miss Lillian Cooper of Ireland, Ind. She died in 1934.

He is survived by four children, Clarkson, Carl and Paul of California, and Mrs. Edwin T. Alsaker of Atlanta, Ga., and five grandchildren. He also leaves three brothers and a sister, Morris, Clarence, Glen and Hattie all of whom live in the county, and a brother, James, of Toledo, O.

The body was returned to Kokomo and graveside services were held at 10:30 a. m. Thursday at the New London cemetery.
