

MRS. S. HENRY DIES

FUNERAL OF RESIDENT WEST
OF CITY WILL BE HELD
SATURDAY MORNING.

Mrs. Mary E. Henry, age 51 years, wife of Sylvester Henry, living nine miles west of Kokomo on road 22, died at 5 o'clock Wednesday evening at the Good Samaritan hospital, where she had been taken earlier in the day for treatment. She had been troubled with diabetes over a long period and her condition became serious two weeks ago when other illness brought complications.

She is survived by the husband, two children, Mrs. Everett Newby, living near Delphi, and Lloyd Henry of four miles west of New London. There are three sisters, Mrs. H. H. Dixon of Russiaville, Mrs. A. G. Ayers of Frankfort, and Mrs. Fred Hobson of New London. There are three grandchildren.

Mrs. Henry was the daughter of William and Melissa Hart, both deceased, and was born July 24, 1886, in Clinton county. The family moved to Howard county soon after and this community had been her home ever since.

Funeral services will be held at 10:30 a. m. Saturday at the New London Friends church, followed by burial in the New London cemetery.
