DORA JOHNSON DIES

FUNERAL SERVICE FOR WEST MIDDLETON WOMAN TO BE HELD WEDNESDAY

West Middleton, Ind.—(Tribune Special)—Mrs. Dora (Wilson) Johnson, 72, wife of Charles Johnson of West Middleton, died at 10:30 o'clock Monday morning at the family residence in West Middleton. She had been in failing health for two and one-half years and some time ago suffered a slight stroke of paralysis.

Mrs. Johnson was born May 15, 1861, near West Middleton. She was one of a family of six daughters of Charles S. and Harriett Wilson, two of whom survive, Mrs. Chambers residing near Russiaville and Mrs. Mattie Hamilton of near West Middleton.

On March 8, 1888, she was married to Charles Johnson. Three children were born to the couple. One son, Stanley S., died in infancy and Frank and Carl Johnson, both residing near West Middleton, survive with their families. There are four grandchildren, Elma Rose and Beulah, daughters of Frank Johnson, and Benton and Gordon Johnson, sons of Carl Johnson.

Funeral services will be held at 1:30 o'clock Wednesday afternoon at the New London Friends church, with the Rev. J. Grant Johnson, minister, in charge. Burial will follow in New London cemetery. The deceased was a member of the West Middleton Friends church and was active in all its departments when her health would permit.
