

Milton Kenworthy, Aged Resident Of New London, Dies

Kokomo friends have been notified of the death Sunday morning at 3 o'clock of Milton Kenworthy, 88, father of the Rev. Murray Kenworthy of Carthage, Ind., former pastor of the Union Street Friends church.

Mr. Kenworthy would have been 90 years old in December. Death followed an amputation of his left leg, made two weeks ago because of a blood clot. Death occurred at the residence of Rev. Kenworthy, with whom he made his home.

Short funeral services were arranged for Monday afternoon at Carthage. The body will then be brought to the Stout funeral home at Russiaville. Services will be conducted Tuesday morning at 10:30 o'clock at the New London Friends church and burial will be made in the adjoining cemetery.

Survivors include the son, Rev. Kenworthy, and a sister, Mrs. Rachel Taylor. He was the father of Earl Kenworthy, former Howard county commissioner.
