

## Miss Eleanor Kessler

Miss Eleanor Kessler, 38, an employe of the Johnson Abstract Co. since 1940 and one of its well known and outstanding staff members, died Sunday at 11 p. m. at her home in New London. She had been with the company for nearly 18 years, until June 1 when illness forced her to leave the firm.

She was widely known in Kokomo's business circles for her efficiency, and her death was a loss recognized by many firms and public officials who knew and liked her.

Miss Kessler was born Dec. 27, 1919, at King City, Mo., the daughter of Glenn and Cora Kessler. Her father died Jan. 1, 1923, and following his death, her mother, now a teacher in the Western schools, moved to New London with her two children.

Miss Kessler was graduated from New London High School in 1938, attended Kokomo Business College and completed the secretarial course there.

She was a member of the New London Friends Church and the American Legion Auxiliary at Russellville, giving both these interests much of her time and attention. She also was a member of the Order of Eastern Star.

Surviving with the mother are a brother, Glenn V. Kessler of New London, and several aunts and uncles.

Funeral services will be held Wednesday at 11 a. m. at the New London Friends Church, with the Rev. Francis Brown in charge, and burial will be in the New London Cemetery.
