## Archie Lindley Dies Suddenly

KEMPTON—(Tribune Area Special) — Archie Lindley, 51, Prairie Township, died suddenly of a heart attack at his home at 4:30 p.m. Friday.

He was born Jan. 15, 1907, in Tipton County, son of Fred and Florence (Heaton) Lindley. He was married to Velma Ratcliff, Aug. 7, 1926, and she was killed in an auto accident west of Russiaville, April 2, 1955. He was married Aug. 17, 1956 to Anna May Quakenbush, and she survives.

Mr. Lindley was a farmer all his life, and had served a four-year term as trustee of Prairie Township.

Surviving, besides the widow, are a son, James, at home; three stepchildren, Mrs. Doyle Hobbs of Tipton R.R., Mrs. Ray Fewell of near Kokomo, and John Quakenbush, a medical student at Indiana University; a sister, Mrs. Harold Vanbibber of near Russiaville, and a brother, Clyde, also of near Russiaville.

He was a member of the Normanda Christian Church.

Funeral services will be at 2 p.m. Monday at the Normanda Christian Church with the Rev. Claire Berry officiating. Burial will follow in New London Cemetery. The body will lie in state at the church for one hour preceding the services.
