

PRAIRIE WOMAN DIES

MRS. J. D. LINDLEY SUCCUMBS
FRIDAY; HUSBAND DIED
PREVIOUS WEEK.

Prairieville, Ind., April 4.—(Tribune Special)—Mrs. Hester Pickerele Lindley, age 62, died at seven o'clock Friday evening at her home here. She had been ill for about two weeks with pneumonia. Her death follows that of her husband, John D. Lindley, who succumbed from pneumonia on Friday, March 27.

The deceased was born February 7, 1869 in Jackson county, Indiana, and was the daughter of David and Mary Pickerele. She came to Tipton county with her parents at the age of ten years and was united in marriage with Mr. Lindley in 1887. She was a member of the Mt. Olive Wesleyan Methodist church.

Three children, Mrs. Ruth Ricketts of Anderson, Frank Lindley of Kokomo and Harry Lindley, survive. There are also four grandchildren.

Funeral services will be held at two o'clock Monday afternoon at the Reserve Friends church. The Rev. Mr. Bodenhom will officiate assisted by the Rev. Mr. Cox. Burial will follow in the New London cemetery.
