

### ALBERT LINDLEY.

Albert Lindley, 83, a lifelong Howard county farmer, died at his home three miles east of Russiaville at 5 o'clock Tuesday morning. He had been ill several months.

Mr. Lindley was the son of John T. and Rachel Lindley, and was born in Honey Creek township. He married Laura Johnson in 1882, and she died in 1914.

Mr. Lindley's home was in Harrison township and he was active on his farm until about a year ago. He was a member of the Friends church at Lynn. *d. 9-14-1943*

Surviving are three sons, Wilmer W. Lindley, of near Russiaville, who is superintendent of Howard county schools; Allen J. Lindley, West Middleton, and Lawrence E. Lindley, Media, Pa.; a daughter, Leota R. Lindley, at home; two brothers, Edgar Lindley, Santa Cruz, Calif., and George F. Lindley, near Russiaville; and a sister, Mrs. Clara Cosand, near Russiaville.

Funeral services will be held at the Lynn church, two miles east of Russiaville, Thursday afternoon at 2 o'clock, and burial will be at New London. The body was taken to the Stout mortuary and will be returned to the residence Wednesday.
