

Mrs. Alice Lindley Dies at Russiaville ¹⁹⁴¹

Russiaville, Sept. 8.—(Tribune Special)—Mrs. Alice Lindley, widow of George T. Lindley,* died at her home here at 7 o'clock Monday morning after a brief illness. She was a faithful member of the Reserve Friends church and led the prayer meeting there only last Wednesday night.

She was born in Tipton county April 17, 1870, the daughter of Simon P. and Mary M. Irby, and was married in 1888 to Henry Jones. They were the parents of three children, including the famous Jones twins. After the death of her husband, she was married to Mr. Lindley in 1892.

Six children survive, as follows: Mrs. Nelle Chambers, Mrs. Lucy Pollock, Miss Crystal Lindley, Raymond Lindley, and Fred Lindley, a step-son, all of near Russiaville, and Mrs. Ivy B.
