

# ARTHUR NEWLIN DIES

FORMERLY LIVED IN RUSSIAVILLE VICINITY; FUNERAL AT NEW LONDON.

Russiaville, Dec. 11—(Tribune Special)—Arthur Newlin, a former resident of this community, but recently living at Logansport, died there Thursday night. He had been in falling health over a long period. He would have been fifty-three years old in January.
