

Obituary.

Nancy A. Newlin was born May 1, 1832, and departed this life Feb. 25, 1897, aged 64 years, 9 months and 24 days. She was the daughter of Solomon and Lydia Whitson and was born in Darke county, Ohio, being the seventh of a family of ten children, all of whom preceded her to the unseen world. She became a christian at the early age of sixteen and later in life united with the Friend's church, of which she remained a faithful, consistent member to the end. On Dec. 13, 1872, she was married to Zimri Newlin, to whom she proved a true and loving companion until separated by the death of the husband about two years ago.

In the death of this dear sister, the family have lost a devoted mother; the church an active worker and faithful elder of many years standing, and the poor and needy a sympathizing friend. She came to the end of her earthly career as calmly as one would prepare for a journey on earth. Although in poor health for several months, she never lost an opportunity to cheer and encourage those with whom she met. Her life and testimony gave clear evidence that she was "only waiting for the boatman." "She is not dead but sleepeth."

Funeral services were held at the Friends' church Saturday morning at 11 o'clock, conducted by Dr. Sylvester Newlin and others. Interment in New London cemetery.
