

Mrs. Mary Ormsby

Mrs. Mary Catherine Ormsby, 82, 1625 S. Market St., died unexpectedly at 11:30 p.m. Friday of a heart attack at her home. She had just received word of the death of her daughter, Mrs. Elsie Robinson, fatally injured in an automobile accident near Winamac. *Sup. 8/24/64 p. 2*

Mrs. Ormsby was born Aug. 22, 1881 in Tipton County, the daughter of William and Mary (Alderson) Wright, but had lived in Kokomo practically all her life. In 1900 she was married to James R. McCoy, who died in 1932. In 1953 she was married to William Ormsby, who died in 1958.

She attended Beamer Methodist Church, and was employed as a cook at the Midget Buffet for many years.

Survivors include six daughters, Mrs. Alvle (Anna) Humble, Mrs. Leo (Mary) Porter, Mrs. Donna Davis and Mrs. Dorothy Murphy, all of Kokomo, Mrs. Loren (Virginia) Reed, Kokomo R. R. 1 and Mrs. Clyde (Wilma) Murphy, Warrensville, Ill. R. R. 1; four sons, Glen McCoy, Kokomo R. R. 1, Ross McCoy, Oregon, Ill. R. R. 1, Robert McCoy of Kokomo and Clifford McCoy of Indianapolis; one step-daughter, Mrs. Harold (Mary Jane) Kelly of Kokomo; one brother, James Wright of Dayton, O.; one sister, Mrs. Sina Dilk of Versailles, Ind.; 44 grandchildren; and several nieces and nephews. Two daughters and one son are deceased.

Funeral services will be at 2 p.m. Monday in Beamer Methodist Church with the Rev. Elmer Thomas officiating. Burial will be in the New London cemetery. The body will be taken to the church an hour earlier, to lie in state.
