

VIRGIL S. PARKER OF NEAR N. LONDON DIES

Virgil S. Parker, 67, living west of New London, died at his home at 6:30 p. m. Monday, following an illness of three and one-half years.

He was born near Flora, Ind., the son of John and Lydia (Kingery) Parker, both now deceased. He was married May 29, 1909 to Lona M. Williams.

Mr. Parker was a member of the Oakland Christian Church where he was a faithful attendant as long as his health permitted and had been a member of the Masonic Lodge at New London 38 years and of the Eastern Star.

Surviving are the wife, one sister, Mrs. Arthur Kelley, 1021 S. Purdum St., Kokomo, and one brother, Elda Parker of Logansport. Two brothers and two sisters are deceased.

Funeral services were held at 11 a. m. Thursday at the New London Friends church with Rev. Paul Relsh officiating, assisted by Rev. Kenneth Luckey. Burial was made in the New London cemetery.
