

MRS. MARY LOU QUAKENBUSH

Mrs. Mary Lou Quakenbush, 71, widow of Oliver L. Quakenbush, died about 6 o'clock Friday night at the St. Joseph hospital, this city. She had been a patient there only a day but had been in failing health for several years. Her home is three miles southeast of Russiaville in Howard county.

Mrs. Quakenbush was born March 28, 1877 in Clinton county, the daughter of John G. and Sarah Katherine McQuinn. She and Mr. Quakenbush were married in April 1898. He died February 10, 1932.
