

Kenneth Rawles

BURLINGTON, Ind. — Kenneth Rawles, 75, Burlington, died at St. Elizabeth's Hospital in Lafayette at 3:48 p.m. Wednesday, Sept. 1, 1982, following a brief illness.

He was born in Nebraska Jan. 13, 1907, the son of Fred and Gertrude (Morehouse) Rawles. He was married May 4, 1935, to Letha Tucker, who died Sept. 14, 1965, and was married Oct. 6, 1966, to Eva Davis, who survives.
