Jerman Rickman Expires Monday

Jerman Rickman, 90, Negro, died at 4:30 o'clock Monday afternoon at his home, 1214 North Kennedy street, following two years of ill health. He had been bedfast most of the time and a few days ago he suffered a stroke which resulted in his death.

He was born in Martin county near Paoli, September 20, 1856. At the age of four years he moved with his parents, Mr. and Mrs. William Rickman, to New London, where he lived until 16 years ago, when he moved to Kokomo. He was a contractor and plasterer. He was a member of the Seventh Day Adventist church.
