

Mrs. Nancy C. Vogus, Howard Pioneer, Dies At Daughter's Home

The last member of one of Howard county's old pioneer families, Mrs. Nancy C. Vogus, age 82, passed away at the home of her daughter, Mrs. Ora Butler, 705 North Armstrong street, at midnight Wednesday. She had been in failing health for the past year and contracted gastric flu a few days ago, which ultimately led to her death.

Surviving, in addition to the daughter mentioned, is a son, Earl J. Vogus, who resides two miles east of Russiaville.

The body was taken to the Eliers mortuary and will be removed to the son's home Friday afternoon, where friends may call after 4 o'clock.

Born in Honey Creek township, Mrs. Vogus spent all of her life in Howard county. She was the widow of William P. Vogus.

Funeral services will be held at 2 o'clock Saturday afternoon at the New London Friends church. Burial will be in the New London cemetery.
