Mrs. Esther Catron Dies at Son's Home

Forest, Ind., Nov. 5 — (Tribune Area Special)—Mrs. Esther Catron, 83, died at the home of her son, Andrew Catron, south of Russiaville at 10:45 o'clock Thursday morning following a five weeks' illness.

She was born October 1, 1859, in Carroll county, daughter of James and Martha Crawford. She was married in 1877 to Adam Catron. She was a member of the Michigantown Christian church.

Mrs. Catron moved to Russiaville in 1909 and had continued to live there. After the death of her husband five years ago she went to the home of her son.

Other survivors include one brother, Elsworth Crawford of Marion; three grandchildren and three great grandchildren.

Funeral services will be held at 2:30 o'clock Saturday afternoon at the Christian church in Russiaville, with the Rev. Mr. Messenger in charge. Burial will be in Russiaville cemetery. The body will be removed from the Lowery funeral home in Forest to the home of the son Friday evening where friends may call.
