### Dies in Kokomo

A native of Russiaville, Mrs. Mable Kinder, 84, B-28 Gateway Gardens, died in Howard Community Hospital early Friday morning. She had been admitted there Thursday.

Born in Russiaville, Oct. 22, 1886, she was the daughter of William and Lillie (Chaney) Ebert. She had lived in the Russiaville-Kokomo area most of her life.
