

Russlerville, Ind., Feb. 25—(Tribune Special)—George Thomas Kinder, 70, died at his home in Russlerville at 1 o'clock Sunday afternoon.

Mr. Kinder was born December 29, 1863, in Clinton county, the son of Joseph and Eliza Kinder. He was the fourth member of a family of six children; only one of whom, John Kinder of Russlerville, survives. The other children were Wesley, William, Mary and Ananda.
