

# Charles Orem

FOREST, Ind. — Charles Dwight Orem, 80, Forest R.R. 1, died at 8:15 a.m. Sunday, June 10, 1990, at Saint Joseph Hospital & Health Center.

He was born Jan. 13, 1910, in Clinton County, a son of Charles Roy and Faye V. (Merrick) Orem.

On Dec. 31, 1932, he married Ruby Lorene Knight who survives.

Orem, a retired farmer, worked for the Indiana Lumbermen Insurance Association from 1928 to 1941. He also drove a school bus for 32 years for Forest and Western schools. He was a 1928 graduate of Forest High School, a member of the Union Baptist Church near Forest and a member of the Russiaville Masonic Lodge 82. He lived in Clinton County most of his life.

Also surviving are two sons, Ted Orem and Jim Orem, both of Forest; Faye Charleston of Tampa, Fla., who was raised in the home; five brothers, Joe Orem of Russiaville, Kenneth Orem of Burlington, Ralph Orem of Michigantown, Leon Orem of Russiaville, and Merle Orem of Russiaville; four sisters, Vivian Karr of Fort Wayne, Ruth Tucker of Colfax, Mary Juanita Sheffer of Forest, and Joyce Adams of Gahanna, Ohio; eight grandchildren and 16 great-grandchildren. One brother preceded him in death.

Funeral services will be held Wednesday at 10:30 a.m. at Stout & Son Funeral Home in Russiaville. The Revs. Meurice Gaylor and Ed Findley will officiate. Burial will be in the Russiaville Cemetery.
