Robert E. Aaron, 81, Kokomo, died 9:35 p.m. Thursday, March 31, 2005, at Howard Regional Health System.

He was born Aug. 15, 1923, in Kokomo, a son of Harry A. and Harriett L. (Hankins) Aaron. On March 16, 1951, at Union Street Friends, he married Janet L. (Sparks) Aaron and she survives.
