Dorman C. Back, 62, 222 W. Hofer St., died at 5:10 p.m. Saturday in St. Joseph's Hospital. He had been a patient there for the last three and one half weeks.

Born Nov. 24, 1898 at Bergin, Ky., he was the son of Alvin and Ora (Fain) Back. He was married March 24, 1921 to Mildred Nave of Kokomo, who preceded him in death.
