Paul Becker, 60, 901 W. Elm St., died Friday morning of a heart attack. He was stricken at 8 o'clock while at work in the fence department of the Continental Steel Corp., was removed to his home and then taken to the hospital at 9:45. He was dead on arrival there.

The deceased was born Feb. 20, 1896 at Houston, Tex., the son of Mr. and Mrs. Frank Becker. He served in the Navy in World War I.
