Miss Julie Elaine Bowen, 18, 6404 Windwood Drive, died at 9:30 p.m. Wednesday in St. Joseph Memorial Hospital from injuries suffered at 8:48 p.m. in a car-truck accident at Ind. 22 and 480W.

Born Jan. 27, 1956, in Lebanon, she was the daughter of Roy B. and Laura (Wagoner) Bowen.

A 1974 honor graduate of Northwestern High School, she was enrolled as a freshman in Grace College, Winona Lake. She was a member of the Pep Club, National Honor Society, Marching Band, Sunshine Society, girl's gymnastic team, Campus Life at Northwestern. She received the Danforth Award for Girls upon graduation. She was a member of Bible Baptist Church and was employed as a relief teller at Union Bank and Trust Company.
