Bowen was one of four people who died in a fire at his home early Friday morning, Jan. 29, 1988.

Born in Peru May 4, 1971, he was a son of the late Gloria Jean Bowen and Everett O. Bowen of Kokomo, who survives.

Also surviving are a sister, Annie Kidd of Peru; a brother, Brian Bowen of Peru; the maternal grandparents, Ralph and Miller Everhart of Peru R.R. 5; and the paternal grandparents, Richard Bowen and Norma Jarvis, both of Kokomo.

Bowen's mother, a brother-in-law, Paul T. Kidd, 23, and a niece, Amanda K. Kidd, 3, all of Peru, also died in the fire.
