

Harlan Bowers Sr.

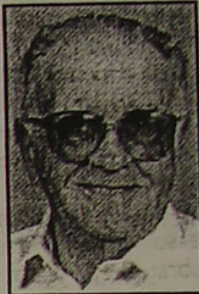
Harlan V. Bowers Sr., 79, 8866 W. Road 200 South, Russiaville, died at 8:29 a.m. Saturday, Jan. 3,
