Wesley Thomas Bowles, 61, 1507 E. Wheeler St., died at 5 a.m. Monday, Nov. 18, 1979, in Wishard Hospital, Indianapolis.

Born in Hopkins County, Ky., July 30, 1918, he was the son of William H. and Ruby (Jordan) Bowles. He was married July 18, 1949, to Millie Joiner, who survives.

He had lived in Kokomo since 1952 and had been employed by Cuneo Press of Indiana for 25 years. He served in the U.S. Navy from 1942 to 1945. He was a member of South Side Christian Church and Kokomo Printers' and Pressmen's Union, Local 302.
