W. Daniel Bretz, 66, 140 Westmoreland Drive W., died at 12:55 p.m. Monday, May 2, 1983, at his home.

He was born in Memphis, Tenn., Jan. 16, 1917, a son of Waverly D. and Vera L. (Canz) Bretz. Oct. 11, 1946, he married June Hinshaw, who survives. *May 3 1983 p 2*

Bretz was an attorney in Kokomo starting his practice in January 1946 after serving in World War II. He received his bachelor and law degrees from Indiana University, graduating in 1941. He was admitted to the bar the same year.

He was active in Democratic politics and served as prosecuting attorney, holding his first office starting in January 1949. In 1980 he moved his office to his home and continued a limited practice.

A life member of Elks Lodge, he was a member of First Presbyterian Church and the Howard County, Indiana and National Bar associations.

Also surviving are a son, Ross Bretz of Kokomo; a brother, Charles Bretz of Jamestown, N.Y.; and two sisters, Vera Bretz of Evansville and Ruth Kisner of Saginaw, Mich.

Services will be at 7 p.m. Thursday at Eilers Mortuary with the Rev. Walter Ungerer officiating. Friends may call at the mortuary from 5 p.m. Thursday until time for the service. Private burial will be Friday at Sunset Memory Gardens.
