Lewis Burcher, 69, Port Charlotte, Fla., formerly of Kokomo, died at 6 a.m. Thursday at his home there following a heart attack.

Born in Quaker City, Ohio, in 1899, he was the son of Mr. and Mrs. Evan Burcher.

In 1934, in Kokomo, he was married to Gladys Cain, who survives.

He was a retired employe of the Continental Steel Corp., where he had worked for 35 years.

A member of St. Joan of Arc Catholic Church here, he was also a member of the Loyal Order of Moose and the Elks Lodge. A veteran of World War I, he served with the U. S. Army in France.

Surviving in addition to the widow are two brothers, Harry Burcher, Urbana, Mo., and Ernest Burcher, Ashland, Ore., 33 nieces and nephews and several cousins.
