GALVESTON - Services for Gifford Cook, 82, Galveston, will be at 1:30 p.m. Saturday in the Thomas-Murray-Funeral Home here, with the Rev. Bob Williamson officiating. Entombment will be in Sunset Memory Gardens Mausoleum. Friends may call at the funeral home from 2 to 9 p.m. Friday.
