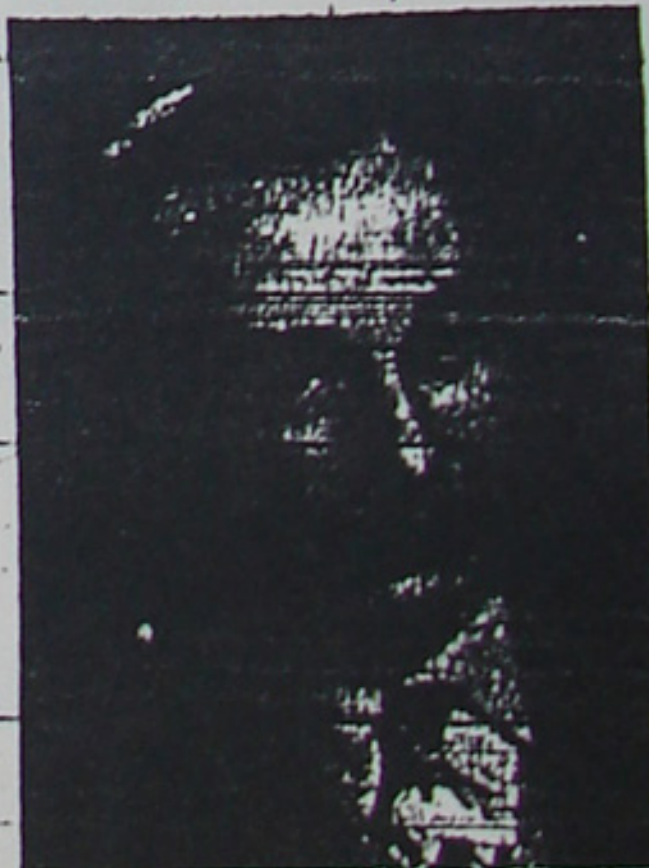
Born in Wabash, Jan. 18, 1897, he moved to Kokomo as a young boy. He was married here in April 1922, to Myrpha Sanders, who survives.
