

William R. Deal Sales Engineer, Dies Here Early Monday Morning

William R. (Bill) Deal, 84, 623 W. Mulberry St., died at his home early Monday morning following an extended illness. He had been a sales engineer for the Philip Carey Co. for 52 years.
