Funeral services for John William Ellis Jr., 68, 419 Rainbow Dr., will be at 9 a.m. Tuesday in St. Joan of Arc Catholic Church with the Rev. Francis Niesen officiating. Burial will be in Sunset Memory Gardens Cemetery.

Mr. Ellis died in St. Joseph Memorial Hospital at 3 p.m. Sunday. He had been ill, but death was unexpected.

Born in Indianapolis, Dec. 21, 1896, he was the son of James and Mary (Garrity) Ellis. He had lived in Kokomo the past 45 years.

In 1919 he was married to Cora Conwel, who survives.

A 1959 retiree of Union Carbide Stellite Division, he had been a foreman there in the roll grind department for 34 years. *4 Jan 1965*

A member of St. Joan of Arc Catholic Church, he was also a member of the Holy Name Society; the Knights of Columbus, and the Quarter Century Club and the Foreman's Club, at the Stellite.

He had served with the American Expeditionary Forces in France during World War I.
