

# Richard H. Gamrath, DiBo Corp. president, is dead

Richard H. Gamrath, 48, 604 Rue De Chateau, president of DiBo Corp., died at 5 p.m. Wednesday, April 26, 1978, in Howard Community Hospital.

Born in Fort Wayne Aug. 22, 1929, he was the son of Harold and Thelma (Myers) Gamrath. He was married in 1952 to Barbara Gonser, who survives. He was employed by Gamrath In-

dustries from 1954 to 1972 when he became president of DiBo Corp. A 1947 graduate of Punahoa High School in Hawaii, he attended Indiana University and served in the Air Force during the Korean War. He was a member of First Congregational United Church of Christ, Elks Lodge, Kokomo Country Club and Columbia Club in Indianapolis.

Also surviving are two sons, Jeffrey Gamrath of Kokomo and Steven Gam-

rath of Lafayette; a daughter, Teresa Gamrath of Traverse City, Mich.; his parents of Kokomo; and a brother, C. Robert Gamrath of Kokomo.

Services will be at 11 a.m. Saturday in First Congregational United Church of Christ with the Rev. John Stoton officiating. Entombment will be in Sunset Memory Gardens Mausoleum. Friends may call from 2 to 4 and 6 to 9 p.m. Friday. The body will lie in state for one hour before services in the church. Memorial contributions may be made to the church or to the American Cancer Society.
