Francis L. Graf, 78, 1714 N. Webster St., died in the St. Joseph Memorial Hospital at 6:50 p.m. Monday following an extended illness.

A former employe of the Cuneo Press of Indiana, he had also been an employe of the former General Electric Corp., the Haynes-Apperson Automobile Co. and American Standard Inc.

Born in Windfall, Aug. 6, 1890, he was the son of Joseph and Sarah (Richards) Graf. He had lived in Kokomo since 1919. *26 Nov 1968 p.5*

In 1917 he was married to Marie Prait, who preceded him in death in 1963.

He was a 50-year member of the Windfall Masonic Lodge and had served with the U.S. Army in France during World War I.
