Arthur Edgar Green, 82, 704 W. State St., died at 2 p.m. Sunday, Dec. 7, 1980, in St. Joseph Memorial Hospital.

Born March 3, 1898, in Kokomo, he was the son of Harrison and Lora (Hockett) Green. He married Alice Miller, July 28, 1925, who survives.
